

Things you need to bring

- Bible
- Note pads
- Pens/ pencils
- Water bottle
- Appropriate and modest clothing (See dress code items, below) and appropriate, sturdy shoes.
- Sleeping bags, sheets, quilts, pillows and other comfortable bedding materials.
- Towels, shampoo, soap, toothpaste/brushes, deodorant, clothes pins and personal care/grooming items.
- Flashlights, cameras, insect repellent and sunscreen.
- Swimsuits and appropriate cover-ups for travel to/from the waterfront area.
- Extra shoes appropriate for swimming and mud. The river bottom and bank at the waterfront are rocky and rough. Close-toed water shoes are recommended.

DRESS CODE

Modest clothing must be worn at all times No camper will be allowed to wear clothing that is too short, revealing, overly tight or otherwise inappropriate. If campers fail to bring appropriate clothing to camp, they will be required to obtain appropriate clothing or be sent home. Campers will wear appropriate shoes at all times when outside his/her cabin. Dress code requirements are:

Clothing containing logos, messages or images of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, profanity or other inappropriate or vulgar language is prohibited.

Male campers will wear pants or shorts and t-shirts or sport shirts. Tank tops are not allowed.
