PERSONAL INVOLVEMENT

New Member Information Packets & Integration: This ministry hands out new member packets, gives a tour of the building and encourages members to become involved in the works of the church.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation: This program provides rides for members to Bible class, worship, other activities as needed.

BUILDING & GROUNDS

Open/Close Building: Members are assigned the monthly responsibility of opening and closing the building during each service (Sundays and Wednesdays). This requires being at the building 30 minutes before service and staying after service to lock up.

FELLOWSHIP

Fellowships & Special Events: We always need help to plan and carry out church fellowships & special events throughout the year.

Classics: This ministry includes activities for the seniors (55 years of age and older). It is designed to improve interaction among church members, and to plan and carry out fun activities outside the church.

PROGRAM DIRECTION

Weekly Worship Assignments: This ministry involves serving in the worship assembly (Opening Prayer, Preside at the Lord's Table, Serving on the Lord's Table, Scripture Reading & Announcements).

Security: Members are scheduled weekly to provide Security during bible class and worship on Wednesday PM and Sunday AM & PM.

Greeters: Members are scheduled weekly to serve as Greeters before bible class and worship on Sunday AM & before worship on Sunday PM.

Wednesday Night Devotionals: Members are scheduled to deliver a 3-5 minute devotional on Wednesday night. (September-May)

Projector & Sound Room: Members are scheduled weekly to work in the projector and sound room.

Class Bells & Attendance Count: Assignment will be to ring the class bell and take attendance for bible classes and worship on Wednesday PM and Sundays AM & PM.

Nursery: Ladies are scheduled weekly to work in the nursery (designed for children ages birth-two years old) during Sundays AM & PM.

YOUTH

- Congregational & Area Youth Activities:** This program involves members helping prepare food, assisting with events, chaperoning and driving when needed.
- Bible Bowl:** Teaching or helping with Bible Bowl classes in the Fall.
- Youth Retreat:** This program involves providing chaperones and drivers for this event.

EDUCATION

- Children & Teen Classes:** Teach or co-teach in our Children & Teen Bible classes.
- Adult Classes:** Teach or co-teach in our Adult Bible classes.
- Ladies' Classes:** Teach or co-teach in our Ladies classes.
- Children's Bible Hour:** This program is designed for children ages 2-10. It teaches important Bible lessons and memorization using puppets and favorite children songs.
- Vacation Bible School:** Teach or co-teach in our Vacation Bible School (Summer).
- Library:** This program is designed to help keep the library in order.

BENEVOLENCE & CARE

- Food Groups:** This group provides food for those who have suffered the loss of a loved one. Food is often taken to homes and/or a dinner may be provided after a funeral service.
- Meals from the Heart:** This group provides meals for families with new babies, those who are sick or shut-in, as well as those in other difficult circumstances.
- Ray of Sonshine:** This program provides care packages to college students who are away from home, missionaries, hospital patients, preaching students, shut-ins and others.
- Help for Widows:** This group provides handy-man type work as a service to our seniors and widows.
- Member Care & Visitations:** This group provides assistance to church members consisting of food and spiritual help. This group also makes sure that members have visits to encourage them when they are unable to leave home or are in the hospital or nursing home.
- Community Assistance:** This group provides temporary assistance with food and spiritual guidance to members of the community who need assistance from the church. Appointments are scheduled each week for these individuals and our members are here to provide assistance to them. Members can help weekly by providing food to the Hungry Howie Program.

WORLD EVANGELISM

- Mission Support Group:** Members correspond with and encourage missionaries and preaching students throughout the year via phone, mail or email.
- World Bible School:** This program is a great opportunity to evangelize around the world by providing Bible correspondence courses. Thousands have been converted to Christ through this effort. Members are assigned to address and grade lessons to be mailed from the church to individuals who request the lessons.

PERSONAL & LOCAL EVANGELISM

- Evangelism and Outreach:** This ministry contacts interested people to study the Bible to discuss spiritual matters, salvation and the church. There are many ways to be involved including door-knocking, personal evangelism, bible studies, fellowship, etc.
- Encouragers' Program:** This program is designed to encourage our weekly visitors, those who are sick and members who have missed recently. Members send postcards and emails, and make phone calls and visits. This group meets most Sunday afternoons at 5:30 PM.
